Gail was born in Melbourne in 1951. She studied at Caulfield Institute of Technology from 1969 until 1973, achieving a Diploma of Art and Design. A Diploma of Education in 1975 completed her formal education.

Gail has been teaching art from 1975 to the present time, including ten years at Frankston Collage of T.A.F.E (1976-86) and currently several classes at the Brighton Recreational Centre. Gail also has a private studio where she teaches private and group classes.

Gail has won many awards, most recently the Best Pastel at the Brighton Art Society Exhibition 2005 and Best Bayside Artist at the Bayside Rotary Art Show 2005. She won best Watercolour at the Brighton Art Society Exhibition 2003, Hodges Acquisitive Prize 2002, Highly Commended Oil in 2002. The same painting was on special display at the 2003 Camberwell Art Show.

Art has been a driving force for Gail and she has sold many paintings in several group exhibitions. These include the Ithacan Society, Market Gallery, Brighton Art Society, Malvern Art Society and many Rotary Art Shows.

Gail has painted several private commissions in pastel, water-colour and oil, from portraits, buildings, animals, landscapes / seascapes and contemporary pieces. The Myer City store and Wrest Point Casino have commissioned her to design and paint corporate and contemporary paintings.

The most recent contemporary commission was for Dr. Harry Marget that had to portray a sense of calm.
